## ***Who is the Folly Lake-Wentworth Valley Environmental Preservation Society?***

We're a group of concerned citizens of the beautiful Folly Lake-Wentworth Valley area of Nova Scotia. We support the Province's designation of the area as a scenic loop where visitors and residents can enjoy "Four Seasons of Outdoor Adventure" and want to ensure that this is protected for all.

## ***What are our concerns about a wind power project in the Folly Lake-Wentworth Valley area?***

The Society supports renewable energy, especially wind power; however we believe that large industrial wind projects such as that proposed for Higgins Mountain must be compatible with the identity and values of the community.

## ***What are the Society's objectives?***

We want the Nova Scotia government to protect citizens of the Province by ensuring that wind projects such as the Higgins Mountain project are developed with the health and welfare of residents as a top priority.

## ***What is the Higgins Mountain wind project?***

As currently proposed, the Higgins Mountain Wind Energy Project would see a total of sixty-nine industrial wind turbines sitting on top of Higgins Mountain along the ridge of the Wentworth Valley from Folly Lake to Ski Wentworth.
